





## WHAT DO WE CHECK?

## Above-Carriage



Examine the upper body of a vehicle for defects and to ensure compliance with the Road Transport Act 1987.

## Thorough Inspection

## **Tinted Glass**



Measure the visible light transmittance rating of windscreens and windows in accordance with regulatory requirements.

#### Brake



Check on a brakes' efficiency and brake imbalance, as well as in parking mode.

### Smoke Emission



Measure the gasses that are emitted from a vehicle's engine to ensure compliance with the Environment Act 1974. As for diesel engines, PUSPAKOM checks on the density of particles via smoke opacity tests while for petrol vehicle, the Hydrocarbon (HC) and Carbon Monoxide (CO) levels are measured.



## Under-Carriage



Visual examination of the under-carriage of a vehicle to screen for any potential defects.

#### Vehicle Plate Number



Check the specifications to ensure compliance with the Road Transport Act 1987.

#### Lights



Check the functionality of vehicle lights.

## Tyres



Check on the condition of tyres to ensure the safety level is met.

## Suspension



Test the suspension system, including performance of springs, shock absorbers and joints on each axle.

#### Side-Slip



Test the alignment of the tyres and road handling effectiveness during lateral movement.
